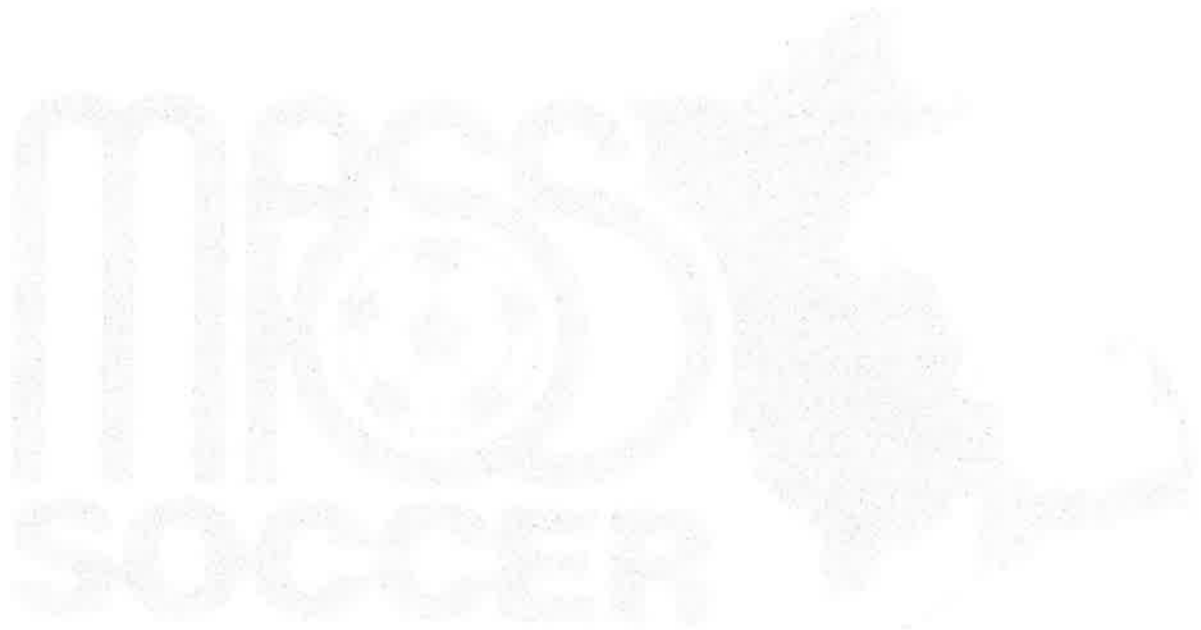

President Cezar Wislocki-Wasecki called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM.

II. Minutes of Prior Meetings

Accept minutes of Semi-Annual Meeting of 11-05-09, motioned Tony Dubrowski, second Brandon Bartley, motion passed unanimously.

III. Vote to approve returning league member Central American Soccer League CSL

Motion by Julian Dunlop to approve CSL as a MASS BOD voting member. This was seconded and passed unanimous.

IV. Reports of Officers

Secretary Report

- ✓ Updated contact list was included with meeting handout, electronic version to be sent to all board members. Collection of bylaws mentioned and requested by Secretary per MASS constitution. More people needed for Disciplinary committee duties.
- ✓ Jonathan Beck volunteered to be MSSL rep for Disciplinary Committee. Mario Santos volunteered to be Disciplinary member for NELASA. President appointed both to committee membership. Motion made to approve appointment of Beck and Santos and all existing members of all committees. Seconded and this was passed unanimously.
- ✓ Suspended players list is updated and posted online.

Vice President Report

- ✓ The new Champions League started with four teams playing on weekday evenings. This year the event will be held between April and August of 2010. Sixteen teams participating for 2010.
- ✓ Tony reported that the Donnelly Cup will be held in July in conjunction with the Veterans Cup. MASS will participate with both men and women's teams. Several out of state teams will be participating. This competition is open to select teams.

Treasurer Report

- ✓ See below for details.

President's Report

- ✓ It was announced that Richard Groff has been selected to USASA presidency.
- ✓ Since our state has mandatory health insurance, MASS is pushing to get a waiver for the medical portion of our insurance bill from USASA.

- ✓ Demosphere database system has been replaced by a new system at USASA yet to be announced.
- ✓ Veterans Cup. Thanks to all who worked hard to make the 2009 Veterans Cup a success. We had 104 teams which is a new record for the Veterans Cup. Thanks to Julian, Diana, Andy and many others for efforts to make the Veterans Cup a success.
- ✓ For the future, hoping for another good 2010 Veterans Cup. Once the Veteran's Cup leaves, Cezar would like to see a New England Tournament, hosted by MASS but covering men, women and different age groups.
- ✓ Committee appointments by President:
 - Donal Keane as Appeal Committee Chair
 - Paul Barrow as Appeal Committee member
 - Carlos Amado as State Cup Commissioner
 - Del Rainho and Al Cordero new positions with Referee Committee
 - All unanimously approved by Board of Directors.

V. Reports of Committees

Registrar

- ✓ Diana is hoping the new database system will be an improvement. Diana is investigating newer pass card systems for league registration of players. There was some discussion on the merits of various systems.
- ✓ All leagues should be sending in their registration database to Diana. Furthermore, additional medical player coverage is available thru USASA.

Insurance Discussion

- ✓ Cezar explained that MASS can request a waiver of the medical portion of the USASA insurance. He pointed out that we paid almost 100,000 dollars in premiums in two years and collected only 2,000 in claims. Much discussion about medical insurance. Discussion of self insurance for medical and MYSA (Mass Youth Soccer) and their self insured policy for medical.

Veteran's Cup Committee

- ✓ Julian Dunlop, committee chair, Veteran's Cup for 2010 will be July 13 –July 18. He repeated the announced success of 2009 Cup.
- ✓ Motion by Julian Dunlop, MASS Soccer should budget to Pay 2011 entrance fees for teams traveling to the USASA Veteran's Cup. Motion passed.

- ✓ Julian recommended that MASS should consider running a late summer tournament each year. Much discussion and agreement.

Report from Referee Committee

- ✓ Andy Weiss spoke with MYSA president and he believes that they would agree to work with MASS for self-insurance for medical for adult players.
- ✓ Referee academy being run by Angelo Bratsis. More referees are seeking upgrades.
- ✓ Committee is considering a financial aid program for younger referees.

Mass Disciplinary Committee

- ✓ Andy Weiss reviewed the method and reasons for reporting referee assaults/ abuse to MASS. Chairman Garrett Solomon not present. Committee activity is ongoing.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

Medical Insurance Waiver Request

- ✓ Motion by Siniscalchi, MASS should request a waiver of USASA Medical Coverage that should result in a reduction of the insurance cost of \$5 per player. Also we will look into self-insurance with MYSA. Brandon Bartley seconded. Motion passed 12-5.
- ✓ Motion by Jim Antonakas, MASS should continue to collect the \$5 per player and keep it in reserve for medical claims. Motion seconded. Motion passed 8 –7.

VII. ELECTIONS - run by VP Tony Dubrowski

- ✓ Slate Proposed, Cezar Wislocki-Wasecki for President. Steven Siniscalchi for Secretary.
- ✓ Tony asked for nominations from the floor, there were none. One vote cast by Tony for the slate. Both executives re-elected.

VII. Constitutional Changes

- ✓ Proposal 1 - Renumbered constitution in two places section 3.9
- ✓ Proposal 2 - Changed timing of AGM sections 3.1 and 4.1
- ✓ Proposal 3 - Allow email for notifications section 4 A 1
- ✓ Proposal 4 - Allow email to replace time stamp for appeals results section 4 A 2
- ✓ Proposal 5 - Allow email section 4 A 5
- ✓ Proposal 6 - Allow email section 4 A 7
- ✓ Motion to accept all changes by Siniscalchi. Seconded. Passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

- ✓ Budget for 2009 was a surplus. International game income was over 30K in income. Veteran's Cup budget of 10 K was only partially spent in 2009. Books being reviewed by present accountant.
- ✓ With 250K in assets, Rich recommends that we should systematically reduce that surplus by collecting less from each of the MASS members. He recommends collecting only \$2.50 per player (instead of \$5) for MASS if they pay their affiliation on time.
- ✓ Motion was by Julian Dunlop to reduce 2010 affiliation by \$5.00 per player, essentially causing MASS to collect no funds toward the 2010 budget. This was seconded. Motion passed by 11-8. MASS will collect \$15 per player for 2010, all of it will be forwarded to USASA to cover affiliation and insurance. MASS will operate on a negative budget for 2010.
- ✓ Motion proposed by Julian Dunlop to hire an administrative assistant. This is recommended by Cezar Wislocki-Wasecki. Approximately \$8,000 budgeted for 2010. Administrative assistant cannot be a board member. Motion seconded. Motion passed unanimous.
- ✓ Motion by Jim Antonakas to budget \$5,000 for champion's league for 2010. Much discussion. Never seconded. Rich has recommended a \$3,000 addition to the budget for Champions league. Motion by Rich to accept the budget as modified by above changes. Motion seconded. Motion passed.


VIII. Adjournment

All business being completed a motion for adjournment was made and seconded and passed unanimous. Meeting ended at approximately 9:30 pm.

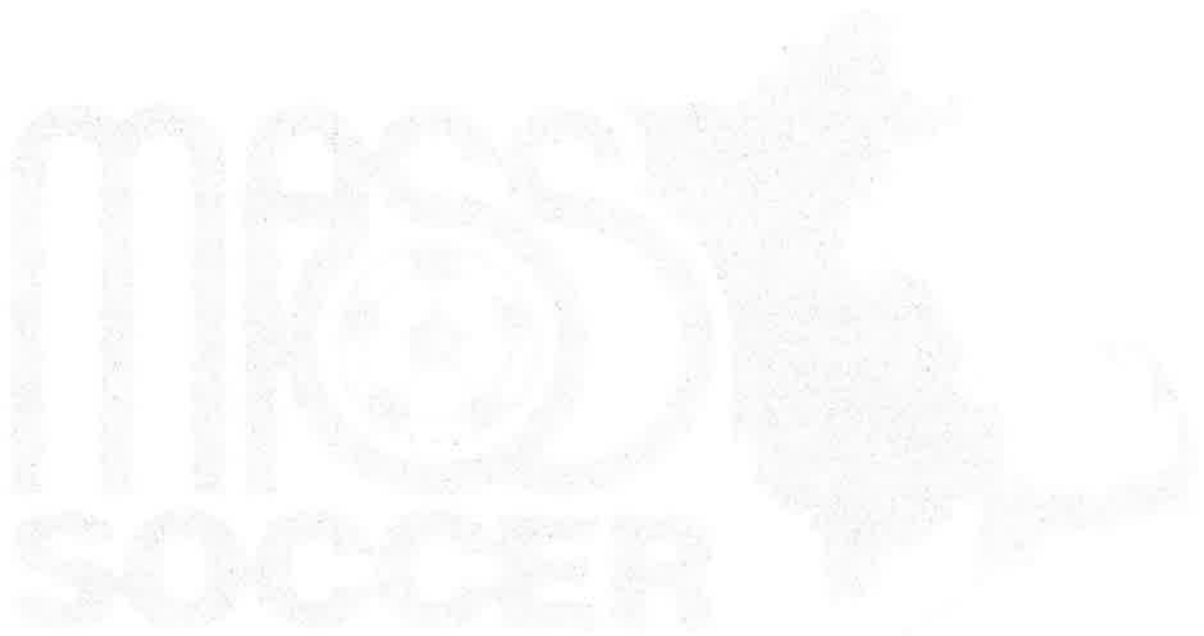

2010 Mass Soccer – AGM Voting Structure

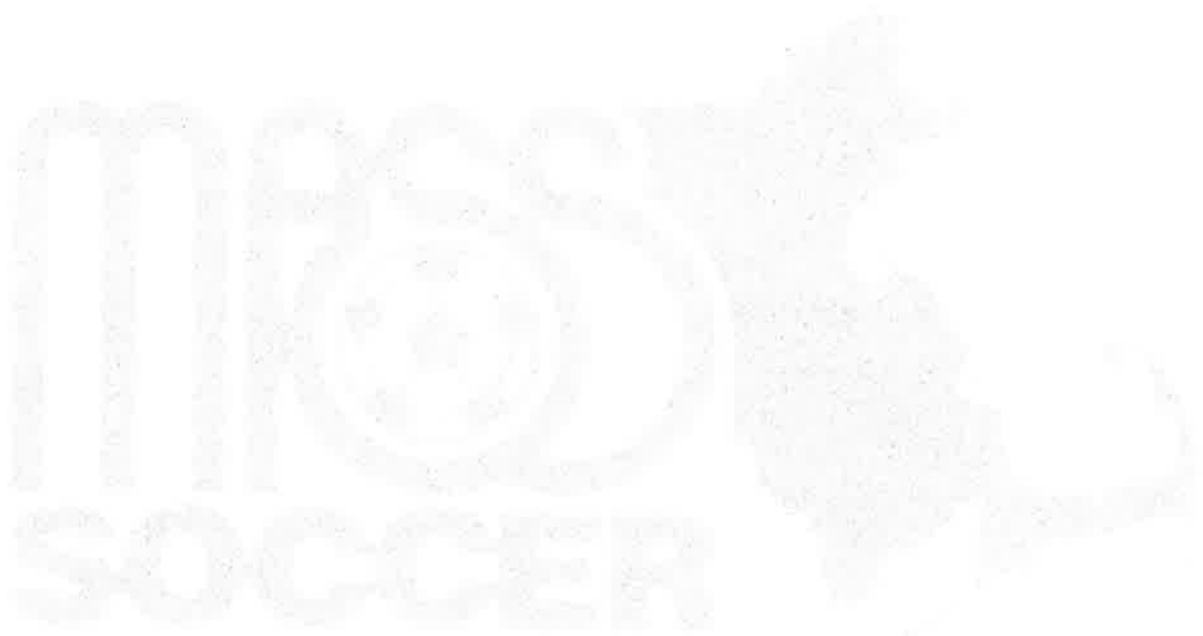

Phase I - 2011

- Online application for all MASS players to register and upload player pictures & govt ID.
- Generate pass cards (driver license type)
- Photo and scanned document upload functionality
- Age validation will be part of the application process. Only valid government ids will be accepted.
- Payment done online via credit card/pay pal
- Export functionality based on matching by MASS ID# (this will require manager to input the id when allocating players to league rosters). Leagues will need to collect MASS ID# on their rosters
- Environment needs to be secure and encrypted
- No credit cards will be stored that are processed!
- Generate receipt for payment and record of transaction
- Some type of admin/reporting tool for leagues officials

Phase II - 2012

- Bi-lingual application Spanish
- Leagues should be able to collect league fee via this workflow by managers paying online (not required to do so)
- Leagues should be able to manage and print league rosters (not required to do so)
- Admin functionality for league so they can do self service
- Enforce league rules based on suspension on league rosters
- Explore if rosters can print player picture next to name

FAQ

- **Why is MASS Soccer proposing this model? Mass Soccer has been looking at centralizing this process for many years. The main reasons are as follows:**
 - Reduce administrative overhead and time spent both for the state association and leagues
 - Keep cleaner up to date player information and eliminate duplicate payments
 - Ensure we are compliant from a liability standpoint
 - Opportunity to reach out to current and past players due to centralized contact information
 - Opens door for sponsor opportunities on players cards
 - Enforce age verification to adhere to leagues rules
 - Centralize the entire process
 - Create visibility to adult soccer and its programs
 - Simplify the insurance waiver process or leagues will have to do this for each player
- **What registration system will you use?**
 - We are evaluating 3-4 mature soccer player registration packages. We expect the systems to cost
- **When will this go into effect?**
 - The goal is to roll this out by early 2010 before the start of the spring season.
- **Why are you not using the USASA registration system?**
 - The USASA new registration package is not ready and we don't expect this to be completed for another year.
- **-How will you validate the age of a player?**
 - The plan for the moment is to validate them the following ways:
 - Organize a couple of big soccer event in Jan/Feb where players can show IDs
 - Office hours with MASS Officers
 - Upload IDs to application

FAQ

- **How does a player get their cards once they have registered online?**
 - Cards will be mailed to the address registered
 - Handed to them during official registration events
- **-Who administer the player cards?**
 - The MASS registrar will be responsible to generate the cards
- **-How much will the system cost to purchase?**
 - We expect to spend somewhere between 5-7K for the entire software and hardware package.
- **-What is the advantage in centralizing the player registration?**
 - Reduced work for both the state and leagues in terms of registration process
- **-How much will a player pay to get a player card?**
 - We expect the annual player fee be somewhere between \$10-15 per player. The player will be responsible for the following fees:
 - USASA yearly fee (set by USASA)
 - Field liability insurance (set by USASA)
 - MASS Soccer yearly fee (this rate is determined by the BOD)
- **-How does the annual renewal process work?**
 - The player will go online and update their contact information and pay for the annual fee. Card will be sent out every year.

FAQ

- **How is the information going to be stored, backed up and accessed securely from your MASS servers?**
 - Depending what route we go build vs. purchase ready product. We are heavily to purchase a package and most of the software packages will be hosted by the vendors and available online. Security for access for our members. Yes we for sure will have a secure set-up as the privacy of our members is critical. Just to give you an example of one of the vendors we will be showing tonight <http://www.clubspaces.com/home.aspx>
- **How will you handle RI and NJH Players?**
 - Yes this will be for any players that play in MASS based league. This will apply for all leagues and refs will not allow any player on the field without the card. The registration of NH and RI players will be a non-issue. We do this today already for RI players. Essentially we would collect the fees based on their fee structure and pass the player information and \$\$ to those states.
- **How are the technically challenged going to be registered? We still have guys out there that don't have ready access to computers.**
 - A technically challenged person can do one of the following things:
 - 1) Attend one of the registration events
 - 2) Attend MASS office hours
 - 3) Have their manager assist them with registration.

FAQ

- **How does red card process work?**
 - The red card process will be established by each individual league. We will let leagues manage their own disciplinary process. The only exception will be ref assault. For those cases the referee will retain the player card and submit it to the association. A hearing will be held to determine if layer was guilty of the assault on the referee.
- **If a player doesn't want to upload their government id what is the process to register?**
 - Players can attend registration specific events and provide proof of age in person.
- **How often will the picture need to be updated?**
 - Exact timing has been established but it will be somewhere between every 3-5 years.
- **What period will the player registration cover?**
 - A player will be registered every year between Jan 1-Dec 31. The first year we will transition some leagues from Sept 1 to Jan 1 by prorating 4 months.
- **How are the ID's going to be validated? How do we prevent multiple ID's being created or duplicate IDs being manipulated? The age of players is a primary concern in our league and a lesser concern in most of the other member leagues.**
 - Validation will be done either by uploading ID to application or by showing us this in person.
 - Multiple IDs dedup tool for exact matches will be in place. Also a player can't register more than once with the same e-mail. Just out of curiosity why would a player would want to register twice and pay additional \$\$?

FAQ

- **Why are you requesting the "Country of Origin" field. Are we maybe scaring off the illegal aliens who are playing in the league.**
 - This is a necessity for the younger age groups because this a big issue for international clearance in the National cups. We can put an explanation how this data would be used.
- **If we don't do this can we stay with the current process?**
 - Yes we can stay with the current system. However, leagues will have to be responsible to collect player liability insurance waivers from every player before they step on the field. This one is non-negotiable as we are at risk for lawsuits.

Dear Cezar:

At the recent USYS annual meeting in Massachusetts many of you heard a report from David Downs, Executive Director of our USA Bid Committee, about the progress we are making in trying to bring the FIFA World Cup™ back to the U.S. in either 2018 or 2022. USSF Vice-President Mike Edwards then stressed the importance to our sport of hosting the event here in America and also introduced the Member Ambassador Program requesting contributions from each of your associations to support our effort.

It would be impossible to overemphasize the importance of this project to all of us. The North Texas Soccer family shares your vision of a nationwide grassroots initiative to host the World Cup and we are excited to once again add our expertise and our members' support to this project and we hope our fellow leaders in soccer join us in this effort."
